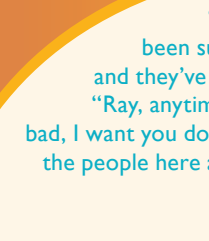

Highlights from 2010

Thanks to the generosity of our supporters and the hard work and dedication of our staff and volunteers, Care Alliance had another highly successful year.

By the Numbers

During 2010, Care Alliance served 9,500 individuals who visited our clinic more than 31,000 times. Of the patients served, 88% were completely uninsured, 95% were living in extreme poverty and 72% experienced homelessness.

Big Developments

After years of planning, Electronic Health Records are coming to Care Alliance in the summer of 2011! Care Alliance anticipates better health outcomes through the conversion.

Recognition

As a primary care partner of Better Health Greater Cleveland, Care Alliance was recognized for outstanding overall achievement in care of high blood pressure, particularly among Medicaid and uninsured patients in 2009 - 2010.
